- Social sustainability

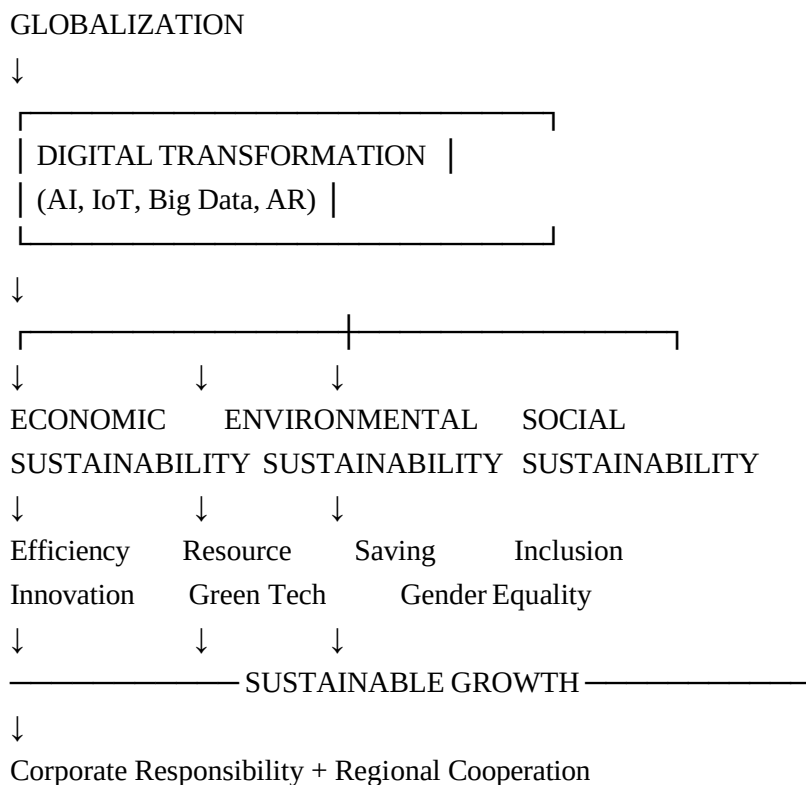
